

The Sign of the eternal covenant of the Kingdom of Israel.

Christ shares what happens to those not in covenant with Him in the parable of salt.

Mark 9:

49 For every one shall be salted with fire, and every sacrifice shall be salted with salt.

50 Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his saltiness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace one with another.

Those who are not in covenant will have lost saltiness and good for nothing but to be thrown out.

Matth 5:13 **Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour**, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.

If the salt lost its savour is reference to losing the salt covenant of God.

leviticus 2:13 And every oblation of **thy meat offering shalt thou season with salt**; neither shalt thou suffer **the salt of the covenant of thy God** to be lacking from thy meat offering: with all thine offerings thou shalt offer salt.

Here we see the sign of the salt of the covenant of God.

Numbers 18:19 All the heave offerings of the holy things, which the children of Israel offer unto the Lord, have I given thee, and thy sons and thy daughters with thee, by a statute for ever: **it is a covenant of salt for ever before the Lord unto thee and to thy seed with thee.**

The kingdom of Israel has the salt covenant.

2 Chron 13:5 Ought ye not to know that the Lord God of Israel gave the kingdom over Israel to David for ever, even to him and to his sons **by a covenant of salt?**

We are the Kingdom of Israel which has not lost the salt.

We are the Salt of the earth as a sign to this Davidic kingdom heirship and eternal covenant.

Matth 5:13 **Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour**, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, **and to be trodden under foot of men.**

But Jerusalem has lost her salt. She is going to be trodden down by the feet of men.

Rev 11:11 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.

2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and **the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months.**

Jerusalem lost her salt and will be trodden down underfoot and given to fire.
